

WERNGOCHLYN FARM COTTAGES
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One of the many beautiful Monmouthshire farmhouses, Werngochlyn Farmhouse dates back to the 12th century. It now is a small working farm set in the middle of rolling farmland with the Skirrid Mountain as a stunning backdrop - and yet only three miles from the busy market town of Abergavenny with its shops, castle, museum, cinema, theatre, wine auctions, annual Shire Horse Show and Steam Rally – and Cycle Race and Food Festival of course! (Pretty much something for everyone!)

We are ideally placed as a base to explore the beautiful Usk and Wye Valleys, the Black Mountains and Brecon Beacons, and there is a wealth of historic buildings and places of interest to visit nearby including Blaenavon which is a World Heritage Site and Hay on Wye – Town of Books, with it's world famous Literary Festival for 2 weeks at the end of May, over the Bank Holiday.

It is an area renowned for its spectacular beauty and is a great place to come for walking, climbing, pot-holing, hang-gliding, fishing, pony-trekking and many more active outdoor pursuits (such as gorge walking or quad-biking) – or perhaps just for relaxing – on a boat along the Monmouthshire/Brecon canal perhaps?

For those of you who like to eat out and enjoy good food, there are plenty of really good restaurants and pubs locally. Certainly, you could visit a different one every night of the week! And, of course, the Michelin starred “Walnut Tree” is within walking distance – across the fields from the Farm. Abergavenny is home to the Food Festival which is held in September and is rapidly becoming one of “The” weekends of the year!

There is a golf course with driving-range ½ mile away (within walking distance) - with many other demanding courses within 30 minutes drive – including the home of the 2010 Ryder Cup, the Celtic Manor, and the Usk river, is one of the best salmon fishing rivers in the country.

Come for a two week holiday and you will still not see it all!

ACCOMMODATION:-

At Werngochlyn Farm we have four self-catering cottages, available all year round, which are set around our farmyard.

They have been tastefully converted and sympathetically restored from old stone farm buildings and yet retain all the charm and character of the original buildings – with stone walls and revealed beams. They all have central heating and are cosy enough for a winter break, or to return to on a rainy summer evening.

There is a heated indoor swimming pool, games room with pool and table tennis, and plenty of room to barbeque or to sit out on the grass. There is ample parking outside each cottage. (PLEASE NOTE THAT THE SWIMMING POOL IS CLOSED FROM NOVEMBER to JUST BEFORE EASTER.)

We run a BHS Approved Riding School and Livery Yard specialising in individual tuition for all ages from 4 years old, with an indoor and outdoor riding arena. Many of our guests take up the opportunity to ride while they are with us and we have started many a young person (and some not so young!) with their first experience in the saddle. Those who ride regularly at home, needn't miss their weekly lesson. There is also stabling for those wishing to bring their own horses on holiday with them. Riding can be pre-booked or you can wait until your arrival.

There are plenty of friendly animals to get to know on the farm – chickens, sheep, goats, ducks, horses, ponies, pigs, dogs, cats and a donkey. It is paradise for children!

A stream runs through the farmyard – care is needed with very small children, but many an hour has been spent paddling and “fishing!”



THE COTTAGES:-

GRANARY COTTAGE – set on one level. 1 double and 2 twin bedrooms, bathroom, shower-room, large sitting room with dining area (big enough to accommodate a large group or family gatherings) and kitchen with dishwasher. Sleeps 6.

STABLE AND DAIRY COTTAGES – 1 double bedroom and 1 twin-bedded room (Stable Cottage has a 3rd bed in the second bedroom), kitchen (with dishwasher), bathroom, sitting-room with dining area. Sleeps 5 and 4.

COWSHED COTTAGE – 1 double bedroom, 1 bedroom with bunk beds (or a small single), kitchen, bathroom and sitting-room with dining area. Sleeps 3 or 4.

All our cottages are fully equipped – the kitchens have a microwave as well as a full size conventional cooker, the bathrooms have a bath with a shower. Each has a colour TV/DVD player, and there is a laundry-room for the use of guests. There is an iron and board in every cottage. Bed linen is provided (but not towels) a cot and high-chair too if you wish. Dogs are very welcome as long as they are well-behaved and under your control!

The three larger cottages have room for a camp bed if you want to squeeze in an extra guest. (It may be possible to have an extra double bedroom with en-suite bathroom in the Farmhouse if you have extra family or friends visiting for a night or two – or even as extra accommodation for the whole duration of your stay.

DIRECTIONS:-

M4 – Exit 24 (Monmouth/Midlands – A465)

2nd Exit – Abergavenny – A40

Follow A40 via Raglan to Abergavenny –

At large double roundabout outside of the town, take A465 – Hereford.

1 mile from roundabout, take 1st turning right – Skenfrith – B4521

T-junction (opposite Maindiff Hospital) turn left.

¼ mile – past Golf Centre and Falconry Centre on your right, take 2nd right – Monmouth – B4233 (next to caravan park)

1/4mile – take 1st left at grass triangle. Fruit Farm on your left.

Werngochlyn Farm is ½ mile on the left – down long farm drive.

From the North and East, take M50 – Ross, Monmouth, Raglan (A40) – then follow directions above.

We are only 5 minutes drive from the big double roundabout outside of the Town and 30 minutes from the Severn Bridge.
